The people from **Scotland** are called **The Scottish**. But you can also call them a **Scotsman**. If someone is from Scotland, then he is **Scottish**.

The people from **Wales** are called "The Welsh". But you can also call them a Welshman. If someone is from **Wales**, then he is **Welsh**.

The people from England are called **The English**. But you can also call them an **Englishman**. If someone is from England, then he is **English**.
