

Prepositions...

indicate some relationship between a noun and some other element in the sentence and are used with:

- **noun phrase** or **pronoun** (most commonly)

e.g.: She fell asleep *during the film.* ; He went shopping *with her.*

- **adverb phrase**

e.g.: *Until quite recently,* no one knew who she was.

- **a verb in the -ing form**

e.g.: Thank you *for cooking.*

- **a prepositional phrase or a wh-clause**

e.g.: Can you wait *until after* my appointment? ; I don't like looking *at what's* in front of me.



Types of prepositions:

- **TIME** (in, on, at, after, until)
- **PLACE** (in, on, at, under, between, over)
- **DIRECTION** (into, to, through, towards)
- **AGENT** (by, with)
- **INSTRUMENT** (by, with)
