

Bedingungssätze, Typ 2

Bedingungssätze vom Typ 2 sind „*Was wäre, wenn...*“-Sätze.

Der Sprecher hält es für **unwahrscheinlich** (oder es ist **unmöglich**), dass die Bedingung aus dem if-Satz erfüllt wird.

if-Satz: simple past	Hauptsatz: would/could + Infinitive
If I were Sean, If I were the DJ,	I would dance with all the other girls. everyone would look at me.
