 I have already baked a cake!

i) Horse

- I have never ridden a horse!
 I have already ridden a horse!

b) Plane

- I haven't traveled by plane, yet!
 I have already traveled by plane.

d) Sushi

- I haven't eaten sushi, yet!
 I have already eaten sushi!

f) Snowman

- I haven't built a snowman, yet!
 I have already built a snowman!

h) Farm

- I haven't been to a farm, yet!
 I have already been to a farm!

j) Moving

- I haven't moved house, yet!
 I have already moved house!
