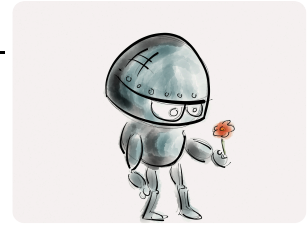


## 1 Future Tenses

### 1.1 Will-Future

**Form/strong:** How does it look like?/p

**Use/strong:** What do you use it for?/p

**will + infinitive // OR // „ll“ or „won't“/em/p**

**We use it to talk about .../p**

**predictions or assumptions, things we cannot**

**Example(s):/p    ma: I think you will &nbsp;like**

**b: I will help you with**

**spontaneous decisions, like an offer or**

### 1.1 Going to-future

**Form/strong:** How does it look like?/p

**Use/strong:** What do you use it for?/p

**am/is/are + going to + infinitive/em/p**

**We use it to talk about .../p**

**fixed plans or intentions for the future./em/p**

**Example(s):/p    ma: I'm going to work when I'm**

**/p    b something that will very probably happen because you can already see signs for it./em/p**

**b: Look at the clouds - it is going to rain!/em/p**

### 1.1 simple present with future meaning

**Form/strong:** How does it look like?/p

**Use/strong:** What do you

**infinitive, but we add an „-s“ for the 3rd person**

**We use it to talk about .../p**

**a timetable, a programme of events, schedule**

**Example(s):/p**

**The next train arrives at 8:30 am./em/p**

### 1.1 present progressive with future meaning

**Form/strong:** How does it look like?/p

**Use/strong:** What do you

**am/is/are + -ing-form + phrase about future time (like „on Saturday“)/em/p**

**We use it to talk about .../p**

**something that is definitely planned or**

**Example(s):/p**

**We are having a barbecue on Saturday./em/p**
