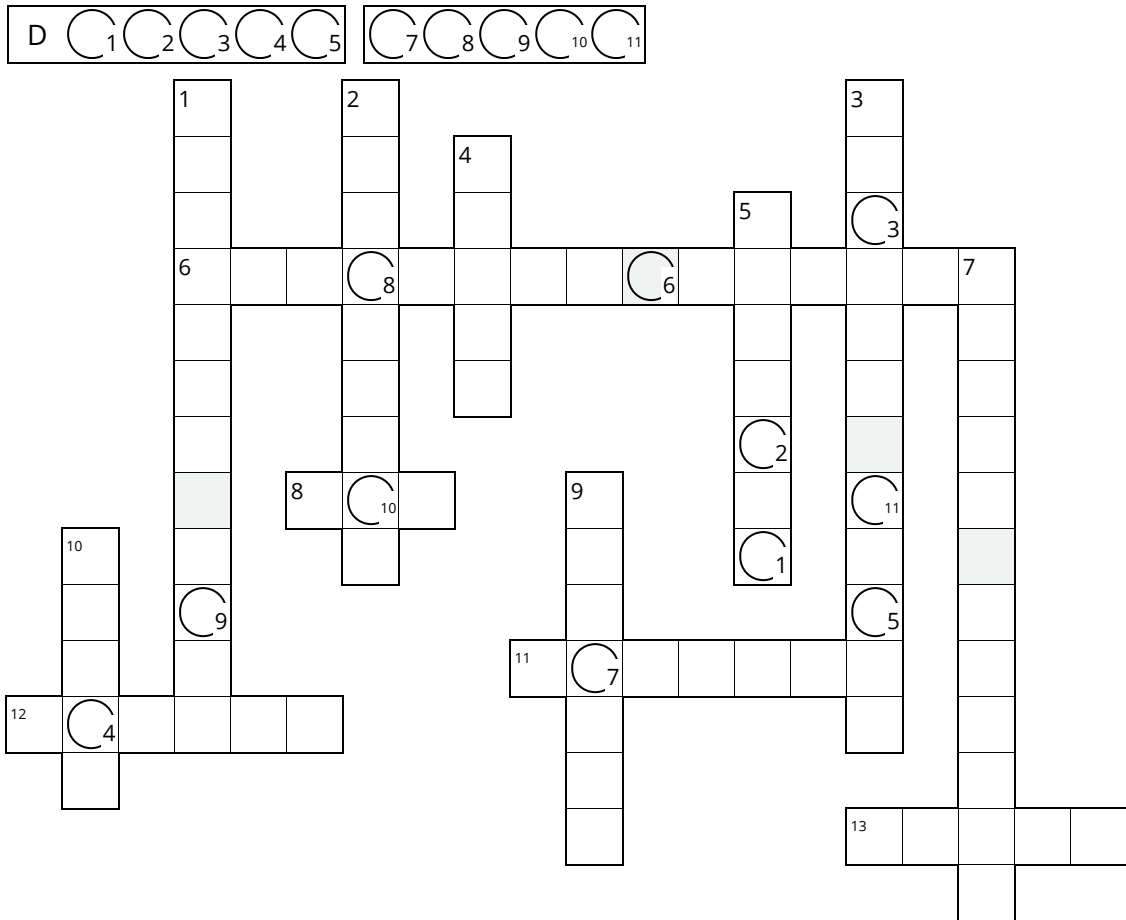


① Where does the patient sit?

| <b>1</b> Protective equipment for infection control                   | <b>8</b> Used for drying teeth and removing debris                         |
| <b>2</b> Used to rinse the mouth and spit out fluids                  | <b>9</b> Instrument used for grasping or holding objects                   |
| <b>3</b> Small, absorbent cylinders used to keep the area dry         | <b>10</b> Device for exposing radiographs                                  |
| <b>4</b> High-speed tool used for drilling teeth                      | <b>11</b> Sharp instrument for making incisions                            |
| <b>5</b> Used to inject anesthetic into the gums                      | <b>12</b> Placed on a patient's chest to keep them clean during procedures |
| <b>6</b> Used to illuminate the oral cavity during procedures.        | <b>13</b> Tool for probing cavities and gum pockets                        |
| <b>7</b> Handheld piece of equipment for examination inside the mouth |  |
