Racism has been a big topic in South Africa's history for hundreds of years. Today still well-known is the system of Apartheid in South Africa, which ended in 1994, when Nelson Mandela became the first black President of South Africa.

- ① Your task is to explain to our audience what Apartheid was, when it took place, who Nelson Mandela was and what you personally think about racism.
- ② In groups of three students (take a look at the **Group Box**), you are going to create a movie with the **app Plotagon**. Create three different scenes which belong together, in which you answer the following questions:
 - What is Apartheid?
 - When did the system of Apartheid begin?
 - How did it happen in South Africa? Give examples.
 - When and why did Apartheid end?
 - Who was Nelson Mandela and why was he so important for South Africa?
 - Is there still racism in South Africa today?
 - What do you personally think about racism/apartheid?
- ③ Be aware that you are not allowed to use the computer voices in **Plotagon!** Use your own voice for the dialogues!
- ④ Be creative and productive!!!
