Die Verwendung von *have got* im present simple

Mit *have got* wird ausgedrückt, was jemand oder etwas hat bzw. besitzt.

① Die Bildung von *have got* im present simple

		Kurzform	Verneinung
I	have got	I've got	I haven't got
you	have got	you've got	you haven't got
he, she, it	has got	he's got, she's got, it's got	he, she, it hasn't got
we	have got	we've got	we haven't got
you	have got	you've got	you haven't got
they	have got	they've got	they haven't got



Achtung:

Bei der **3. Person Singular** verwendest du immer **has got** bzw. **hasn't got**!

② Die Bildung der Frage mit *have got* im present simple + Antworten

	Kurzantwort	Verneinte Kurzantwort
Have I got...?	Yes, I have.	No, I haven't.
Have you got...?	Yes, I have .	No, I haven't .
Has he, she, it got...?	Yes, he, she, it has .	No, he, she, it hasn't .
Have we got...?	Yes, we have.	No, we haven't.
Have you got...?	Yes, you have.	No, you haven't.
Have they got...?	Yes, they have.	No, they haven't.
