**Follow these easy steps to describe a picture:**

1. Say what the picture is about.

*This picture is about the summer holidays.*

*This is a photo of London.*

*This picture shows many different sights in New York.*

2. Describe the picture.

**What's in the picture?**

*In the picture I can see ...*

*There's There are ...*

*There isn't a ... There aren't any ...*

**What is happening? / What are people doing? Use the present progressive.**

*The girl is ...ing*

*The people are ...ing*

*It's raining.*

**Where are people / things?**

**In the top left hand corner...**

**At the top...**

**In the top right hand corner...**

**In the background...**

**On the left...**

**In the middle/  
In the centre...**

**On the right...**

**In the foreground...**

**In the bottom left hand corner...**

**At the bottom...**

**In the bottom right hand corner...**
