How to describe a picture

In some lessons or exams you have to talk about a picture (a photo, a painting / drawing). Before you say something or answer questions, **look at your picture carefully and take notes**. Don't forget to **include useful phrases!**

Follow these easy steps to describe a picture:

1. Say what the picture is about.

*This picture is about
the summer holidays.*

This is a photo of London.

*This picture shows
many different sights
in New York.*

2. Describe the picture.

What's in the picture?

*In the picture I can see ...
There's / There are ...
There isn't a ... / There aren't any ...*

What is happening? / What are people doing? Use the present progressive.

*The girl is ...ing
The people are ...ing
It's raining.*

Where are people / things?

In the top left hand corner...

At the top...
