A book review

A book review is a form of literary criticism in which a book is analysed based on content, style, and merit. It has an introduction, a main part and a conclusion.

① Introduction: Fill in the correct words.

② Main Part

opinion plot outline

This section consists of a short and the writer's about the central aspects of the work, supported by facts and examples.

③ Conclusion

Here the writer's is summed up and the conclusion usually includes a or a . Often presented as a rating.
