

Revision: Emphatic forms

① **emphatic 'do':**

- used to give extra force to the main verb.
-> I **do** like your new jacket!

② **adverbs of degree:**

- describe the degree or the intensity of an adjective.
-> You are **completely** wrong.
Other adverbs of degrees: absolutely, certainly, clearly, definitely, naturally, obviously,...

③ **emphasis with 'what':**

- 'what' at the beginning of a sentence emphasizes an action.
-> **What** I really love is going to the cinema.

④ **emphasis with 'it was/it is':**

- It is... / was...
-> **It isn't** Sam who is going home, **it's** Jill.

⑤ **emphasis with self-pronouns**

- emphasizes a noun in the sentence.
-> The Queen **herself** attended the party.
