When do we use it?

① something started in the past and continues in the present/is finished
I' ve hurt my foot. It hurts when I walk Olivia has bought new running shoes. The're still clean
Example:

- 2) we are talking about our **experience up to the present**. We can also use it to **ask ques**tions I have never watched football. I'**ve seen** that film before. Has Johanna ever done her homework? - No, she hasn't **Have** Mike and Jeremy ever **run** a marathon? - Yes, they **have**. They **have run** one three times. Example:
- 3) something **happened in the past** and the results can be **seen in the present** Olivia **has** already **cooked** dinner. (There is food on the table) Joachim **has** just **watched** the news. (He knows about current events) The students **haven't done** their homework yet. (Their exercise books are empty) Example:__
