Why who?

We use who, if we talk about Person!

Example:

He cleaned his bike yesterday.

Who cleaned his bike yesterday? He!

Don't use who for things or anything like that. Who is everytime only for Persons/ Charakteres



Why which?

We use which, if we talk about things!

Example:

That is the phone which is broken.



Why that?

We use that for things and Persons!



Don't forget!

who, which or that are relative clauses. They are to describe things or People in detail.

Example:

You have four boys. You want to describe who of them is your brother.

My brother is the boy, who/that wearing a watch!
