

**Gegenwart (present)**

- simple present: Infinitiv (bei he, she, it: +s)

- present progressive: form von "to be" + verb + -ing

**Vergangenheit (past)**

- simple past: verb + -ed ODER unregelmäßige Verben  
=> AUSWENDIG LERNEN

- past progressive: Vergangenheitsform von "to be" (was/were) + verb + -ing

- present perfect: have/has + past participle

**Zukunft (future)**

- will-future: will + verb

**Beispiele:**

simple present: I walk. / He walks.

present progressive: I am walking.

simple past: I walked.

past progressive: I was walking.

present perfect: I have walked.

will-future: I will walk.

**Formen von "to be"      Gegenwart      Vergangenheit**

I	am	was
you	are	were
he, she, it	is	was
we	are	were
you	are	were
they	are	were
